

RED STAG OR FAIR CHASE UP TO 360

Free Range Red Stags are traditional in antler formation, judged in the same way by points that they grow with 35 inch+ main beams. There are no score classes as we hunt the oldest and biggest we can find on private land, Stags range from 5x5-8x8.

With the Fair Chase Stags it is up to 360 inches, where you will typically see between 4-10 trophy mature stags in a hunt they are larger than free range wild Red Stags with more mass and length and can have 2-4 more points.



Elk has always been one of the most difficult trophies to bag in New Zealand. This huge deer is the largest of the round-horned deer in the world, with heads running 6×6 (12 points) and larger. The best Elk trophies often exceed sixty inches in length.

Like the red deer, New Zealand elk rut (bugle) in March and April but can be hunted from the middle of February until September.



WING SHOOTING

New Zealand has a total of 13 huntable species with daily bag limits between 2 - 25 depending on the species. Wingshooting is unique here, allowing you to see birds available no place else on earth.

This hunt should not be considered a high-volume hunt, but more an adventure for the collector, and for someone seeking a totally unique experience.

Our main waterfowl season is the first weekend of May through July with an early short season in March. Merrium turkey hunting hunting is an open season.



The central South Island fishing season is 1st October through 30th April, high country lakes and streams open on the first Saturday in November. Canals and many lakes can be fished all year.



GENERAL INFO

Fitness Required: Every year we have hunters of all abilities. The saying that the more you put into it the more you get out of it is always true, so getting any form of exercise will certainly help. Having a weighted pack and climbing stairs is a great way of getting you prepared. With the quantity and quality of our properties and the roads on them, your guide can and will quickly access and tailor the hunt to the clients ability level. We have had successful foot hunters from 8 & 9 yrs to experienced 73 & 84 yrs old. All these hunters, and many more, were successful in taking their animails on foot without a helicopter.

Air Travel: Most flights arrive from New York, San Francisco, L.A, Chicago, Vancouver or Houston into Auckland, which is an overnight 12-14 hr flight. The main carrier is Air New Zealand which has won numerous awards. Travel Insurance is recommended and a passport is required. A visitor's Visa permit is issued on arrival into New Zealand. Your final destination will be either Timaru or Christchurch in the South Island. We are 35 minutes from Timaru Airport and just over 2 hrs South of Christchurch International Airport.

NZeTA: Most visitors to New Zealand will need to apply for a New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority once flights have been booked. We will provide you with the link where you can apply for your NZeTA.

Hunting Properties: New Zealand Safaris operates on leased private land. These huge properties are all within 5-30 minutes of the lodge. Each species we hunt has 2-4 properties. Which means the game have less pressure from hunting, it gives us the option to change properties according to weather and hunter's ability. Every hunter or party can have their own property to hunt on. These ranches (stations) range from 8,000 - 47,000 acres, all working sheep and cattle ranches. New Zealand Safaris has access to the largest and most diverse types of privately owned hunting properties in New Zealand, both free range or fair chase estate properties.

Importation of Firearms: We will supply you with an online link to apply and pay for your NZ visitor firearm license and import permit to bring a rifle or shotgun. Bows do not need a permit. The form needs to be completed at least one month in advance of travel. Leaving the country nothing further is required. If you are traveling from the US, you will need to complete a US CBP form 4457 prior to leaving to ensure a problem free return to the US.

Recommended Calibers: Anything from .270-300 is ideal, Bow 60 lb+. Shotgun for bird's 12g is preferred if shooting multiple species. New Zealand Safaris can also supply you with a firearm should you choose not to travel with one.

Shot Distances: Using a rifle most shots will be between 100-350 yards depending on the hunter's ability, animal and terrain being hunted. It is recommended to bring a bipod for your rifle, be familiar with your rifle ballistics, and shooting up and down hill. Bow hunting distances vary between 30-80 yards depending on animal and terrain hunted also, preparation for shots on an angle should be practiced.

Power: We operate on 240 volts, 2-3 pin configuration, which requires a plug adapter and converter although most electronics now operate on both. We do have spare plug adapters at the lodge.

Hunting Clothing/Equipment: We will provide you a list of recommended gear to bring which is also listed on our web site. We do have some spare clothing for use and for sale. It is important to make sure your gear is clean on arrival especially your boots. And declare any food, as fruit and some items are not permitted.

Trophy Preparation: Your trophies will be field dressed out on the hill after photos. From there they are tagged, placed into a bag and stored in a freezer until the end of the hunt where we will take them into our expeditor. We leave the care of salting, creating and expediting your trophies to the experts. They will ensure you receive your trophies back within 3 months. Or if you choose our taxidermist Tyron Southward can mount and ship your animals as you would like. Tyron is considered the best in the business in new Zealand turning your trophies into art, as a passionate hunter himself he has intimate knowledge of the New Zealand animals turning them into life like creations.
